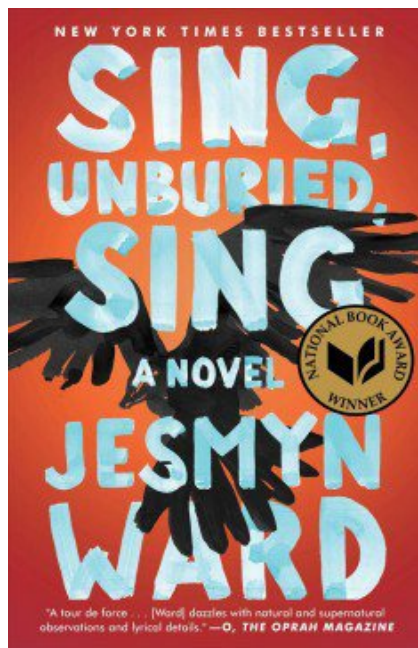




Monday Evening Book Discussion
