Dear Assemblymember McDonald / Dear Senator Ashby,

While the Governor's Executive Budget provides a slight increase in Library Aid (+\$2.5 million, to \$102.1M), and keeps Construction Aid flat at last year's level (\$34 million) libraries have been under-funded for years.

As library operating costs increase, this chronic under-funding jeopardizes libraries' ability to provide valuable services to the community. **We ask that you increase funding for NYS Libraries!** We also ask that you support the Governor's appropriation of \$3 million for the New York Online Virtual Electronic Library (NOVELny), a free online library of magazines, newspapers, and reference books available to all New Yorkers.
